



A NEW IMPERIALIST SUMMIT: G8 SUMMIT

G8 Summit, formerly known as G8 before the collapse of revisionist Soviet Union and existence of imperialist Russia, revise imperialist exploitation and pillage policies, reshaping of the world, and most importantly their position against working class and national struggles.

Getting courage from the lack of a socialist power, few imperialist brigands attack working class and peoples to seize their rights, which were gained after long-term struggle 1917 October socialist revolution. Globalisation and privatisation mean mere exploitation, more job cuts, and more attacks against trade unions, the social and economical rights of working class. But, the imperialists have presented the globalisation and privatisation as the rescuer policies of the world and tried to annihilate the struggle of working class. Today the world's working class faces the ruining consequences of privatisation; therefore, the struggle against privatisation increases every passing day. Imperialist brigands today unlimitedly exploit the working class of colonial and semi colonial countries as well as those of their own countries.

Globalisation, at the same time, means more human rights violation, disappearances in detention, massacres, bloody suppression of national and class struggles. The imperialists claim to be the champion of democracy. But, they are very keen on carnage in order to protect their system. Some examples of their characteristics are as follows: The planning and directing of military coups in Latin America and Asia, organizing and financially supporting the counter movements against revolutionary organisation, pouring tones of bombs on people in order to control some puppets as happened in the Gulf War and Serbia. Despite their murdering characteristic, they have deceived working class and peoples of the world by presenting them as human rights defenders. On the other hand, they issued anti-terror law in their countries and propagated them to the rest of the world in order to prevent working class struggle for socialism.

Globalisation means the destroying of ecology globally. The humanity is under threat because of ecological disaster caused by imperialist trust's chemicals and wars.

The working class and labourers of Turkish, Kurdish and other ethnic origins today suffer from extreme exploitation by both Turkish ruling class and imperialists. Because Turkey is a semi colonial country.

Imperialist global attacks are practiced in Turkey in all dimensions. Today, Turkey's economy is run according to IMF and World Bank's programmes. Privatisations, low payment, job cuts and anti-unionist policies are practiced. Working class struggle continues against imperialists and their collaborator Turkish bourgeoisie's attacks. Meanwhile, revolutionary and socialist movements, which have long-term illegal struggle experience, continue to become the nightmare of imperialists and their collaborator.

Therefore, the imperialist and their collaborators have launched a well-planned campaign in order to annihilate or marginalize the revolutionary and communist movement and Kurdish National Movement. As a part of this plan, Abdullah Ocalan, the leader of Kurdish National Movement, was captured with an imperialist plot and put into a jail on an island on his own. Today, they try to surrender the Kurdish National Movement.

The F-type isolation prisons have been introduced in order to surrender the revolutionary and communist movement and those who oppose the fascist Turkish regime. The fascist Turkish state launched an attack on 21 prisons on 19-22 December 2000, murdering 30 political prisoners and maiming hundreds, in order to transfer political prisoners into the F-type prisons. The political prisoners have gone on hunger strike and death fast in protest against F-type isolation prisons for 8 months, and as a result 24 political prisoners and 5 relatives have died. The resistance continues with new participants. They have not been surrendered, in spite of being put into isolation cells.

Today, supporting the resistance of political prisoners in Turkey means the struggle against imperialism and its collaborators, and supporting the resistance against the attack to surrender the revolutionary and communist movement in Turkey.

Presenting its communist greetings to the struggle against imperialism and imperialist brigands' summit, our Party calls upon all anti-imperialists to support the working class and labourer peoples' struggle against fascism in Turkey.
