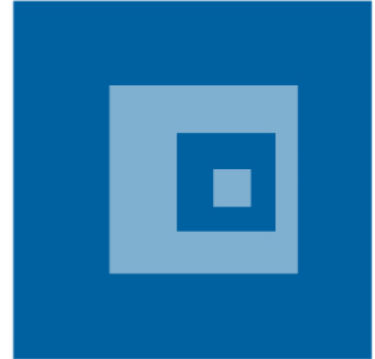

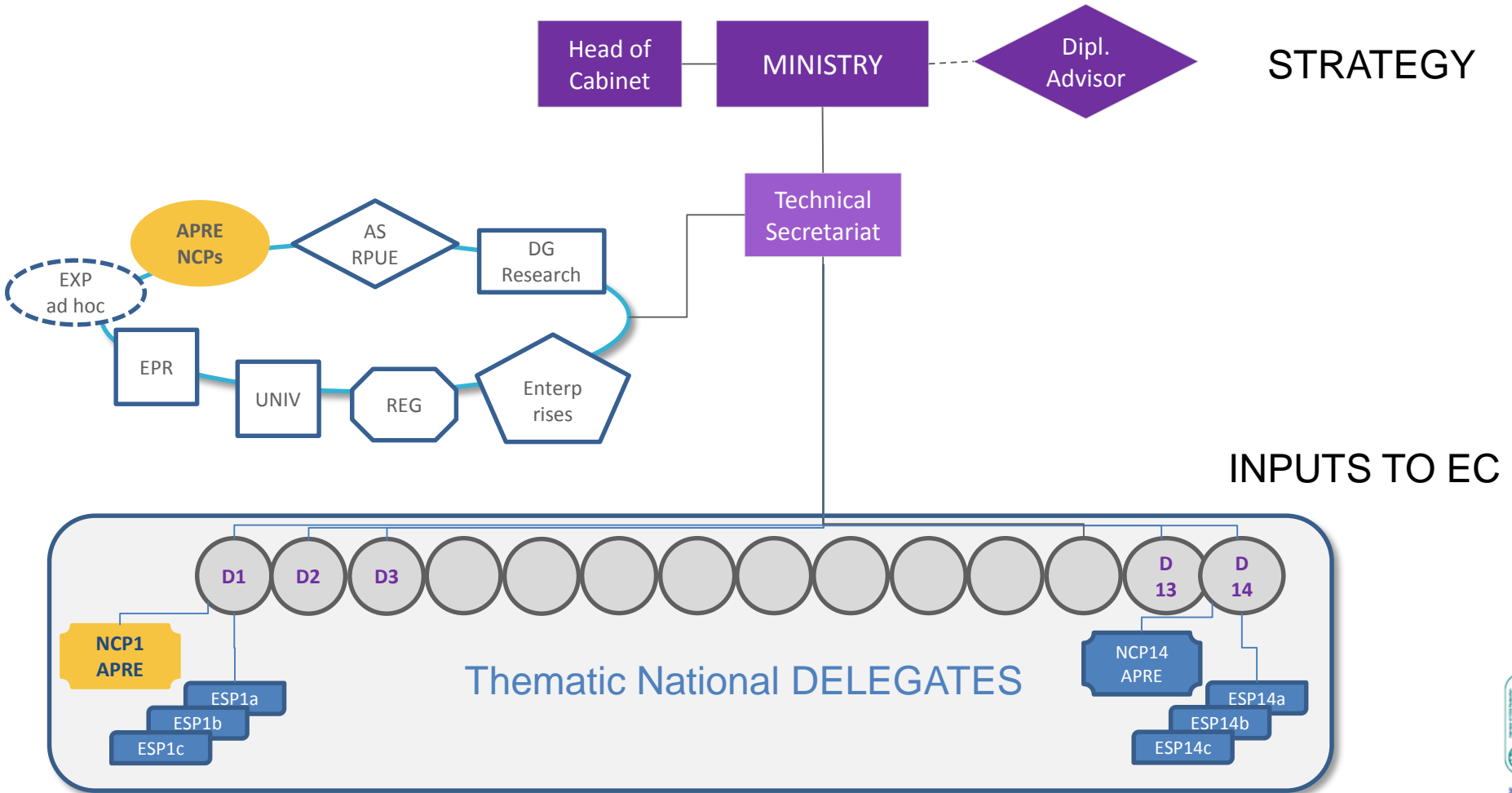

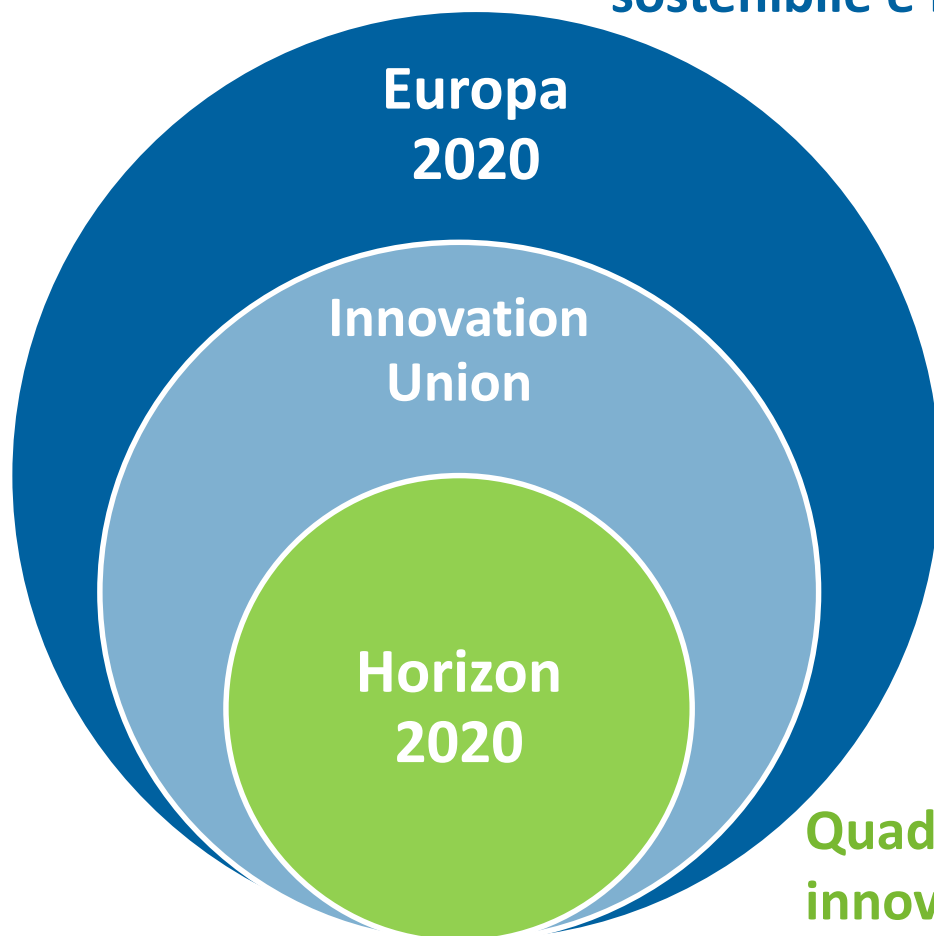

Achieving impact through Social Sciences and Humanities

The scientific impact of EU-funded research in the Socio-economic Sciences and Humanities (SSH) is well-documented. Preliminary findings from the IMPACT-EV project show that SSH projects funded under FP7 have generally published an average of 16 articles in peer reviewed journals. Our projects are also instrumental in strengthening cooperation and networking between researchers at European and international level and in reinforcing the European academic environment. Furthermore, SSH research can have much wider societal impacts by informing policies and institutions tasked with tackling major societal challenges, ranging from growth and full employment, to sustainable development and the management of migration.

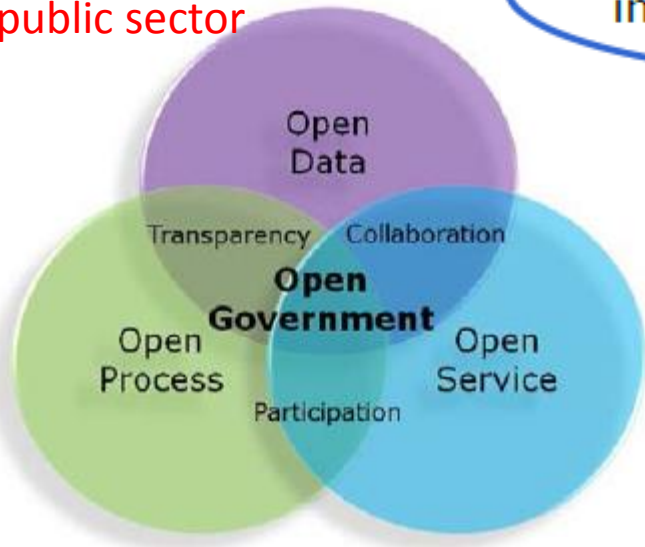

The open government approach enables public bodies to be more transparent and open, more accountable and more agile.

The new technologies being deployed and adopted by the public sector are bringing in new, innovative ways in which citizens and businesses interact with public authorities; new ways of working for administrations themselves; and providing new business opportunities through the re-use of public sector information and collaborative production of services.

The Malmö Ministerial Conference on eGovernment set out the vision in 2009, to make European public administrations open, flexible and collaborative in their relations with citizens and businesses. The vision was translated into several concrete actions through the open government concept, in the European [eGovernment Action Plan 2011-2015](#). In particular, a number of [eParticipation](#) and [innovative eGovernment projects](#) have been launched to increase the capacity of citizens, businesses and other organisations to be pro-active in society, using new technological tools and innovative technical approaches.

The HERA (“Humanities in the European Research Area”) Network invites researchers to apply for the participation in the “Uses of the Past – Matchmaking Event” taking place in Tallinn on 29 January 2015.

The aim of the Matchmaking Event is to present the Call for transnational humanities-led research proposals under the theme “Uses of the Past” to be formally announced early January 2015 and to facilitate the building of international research partnerships. With up to €23 million available, the research programme will fund new and exciting Humanities-centred projects on Uses of the Past involving researchers from four or more countries.

The deadline to register your interest in attending the Matchmaking Event is **5 November 2014, 14:00 CET (Central European Time)**.

Eligible scholars are senior and early career researchers based in the following participating countries: **Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, and United Kingdom.**


To attend the Matchmaking event, scholars must submit an Expression of Interest for participating in the event consisting of a short project idea and a short CV. More information about this call and how to submit an application can be found here <http://www.b2match.eu/hera-up-mme>. The travel costs of the selected applicants can be reimbursed up to EUR 350.
