Education and Training for co-operative development

IRECOOP Emilia-Romagna is the vocational training centre created in 1979 by Confcooperative Emilia-Romagna to meet the training needs of the regional cooperative system.

MISSION:

- 1. To be a **tool for the development** of new skills and for **the innovation** of the local productive background, starting form the cooperative enterprises and their members;
- 2. To **develop**, **promote** and disseminate the co-operative culture and its principles;
- 3. To Support people professional growth to access the labour market





Main Areas of Action

- Education and Training training, refresher and specialization courses; vocational training and guidance.
- Guidance and support services to self-entrepreneurship
- Tailored training activities for co-operatives operating in the fields of agribusiness, social and health services, banking, logistics, tourism and culture, green economy;
- Co-operative Education in primary and secondary schools;
- Research on co-operative skills need;
- International projects





European and International activities

- participation in European Projects (focus on: Lifelong learning and mobility, Co-operative entrepreneurship and promotion of the cooperative model as self-entrepreneurship opportunity, Integration through work of disadvantaged people). On-going ex.
 - Golden Valley Croatia (Social Entrepreneurship as Integration Model for Former Drug Addicts)
- Support to co-operative enterprises to set up and manage transnational projects on different social, health, work, culture, organizational innovation related topics
- Targeted training interventions addressed to co-operative enterprises to train the internal staffs on the access to EU Funds.

Cooperation promotes key competences for the Employability of Young people

LLP Programme – Mobility PLM

Transnational mobility for 49 young people (19 – 35) from the Italian Regions of Emilia-Romagna and Puglia.

3 scholarships for people with special needs

Direct aim \rightarrow to provide young people with an opportunity to acquire specific competencies in the field of cooperative enterprises, with a focus on external relations, external trade and innovation.

Indirect aim \rightarrow to boost the potential of cooperative enterprises in the creation of new jobs, particularly in the field of external trade, foreign languages and innovation





- 18 Italian Partners + 16 Foreign Partners
- 8 European countries involved → France, Germany, United Kingdom,
 Spain, Belgium, Poland, Malta, Sweden
- **2 weeks** linguistic preparation **+ 13 weeks** internship in cooperative businesses, their representative bodies, trade unions, Chambers of Commerce, training centres and public bodies
- Focus on 4 strategic sectors: agribusiness, environment, logistics, social health sector.
- Project duration: October 2012 February 2014. Call for application closed in January 2013 – I flow April-July 2013 – II flow on-going







First RESULTS ...

- 301 received applications
- 40 participants selected for the 1° flow (1 participant with special needs) and 9 for the 2° (2 participants with special needs)
- Preparation and training on cooperative entrepreneurship realized before departure
- 4 participants continued to collaborate with the coops that hosted their internships
- 7 participants found new opportunities connected to their internships
- 3 participants came back to their coops with more skills and new ideas
