Rolling executions in its path, a wave of tons of thousands of migrants and refugees - many fleeing from wars in Imq. Syrin and Afghoristan - has worked its way up the length of the Balhans in recent days.

Like a movable least of despair, the mass of people has overwhelmed the authorities in one stop after another, from the Greek island of Kos to impover shed Macedonia, which declared a state of emergency last week, and now the train and bus stations of Serbin, as they head sorth to their ultimate destinations in the richer nations of the European Union.

#### Stock slide in China fuels global market rout

Sharp drop in Shanghai spills over into Europe: U.S. pares early losses

investors' concerns over China's economic slowdown and a souring view of energing economies reverberated around the world on Monday, contributng to a broad sell-off in European stocks that initially carried over into United States trading

While it and other major American indetect had pared much of their early losses by early afternoon in New York, trading remained volatile. And the Dow and the broader Standard & Poor's 589stock index were both still down for the

Earlier on Monthsy, China's benchmark Shanghai composite index closed 8.5 percent lower, erasing all of the gains t had made in an extraordinary run this year. In Europe, the main indexes ended the day down around 5 percent.

Dan Greenhaus, the chief global strategist at the brokerage RTIG, said many global investors ended last week hoping that the Chinese government would step in over the weekend to annames some steps to support the markets, but nothing significant happened, contributing to the pessimism on Monday inoming
